4	I Will Survive	Intro strumming and first verse (At first) are SLOW. Then speeds up (about double time) starting with 2 nd verse (And so you're back) through remainder of song.
5	That's the Waymedley	1-2-3-4.
6	Dancing Queen	1-2-3-"Oh …" Last time chorus, then Coda at bottom
7	Stayin' Alive	1-2-3-"Well" Slow, swing version
8	Shake Your Groove Thing	1-2-3-4. Prepare for the bridge on the 2 nd page and the chords after the chorus!
