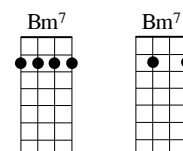
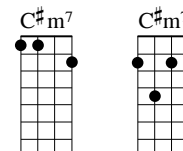
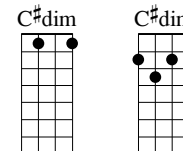
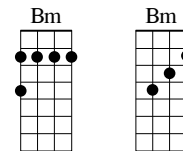
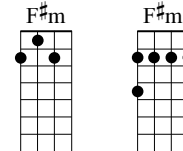
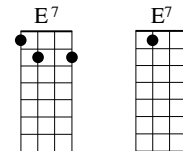
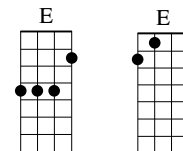
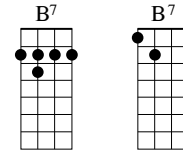
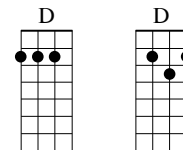
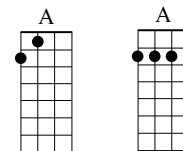
Guess I'll get dressed and do the town.
