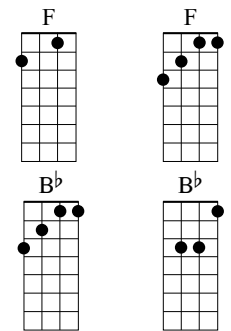

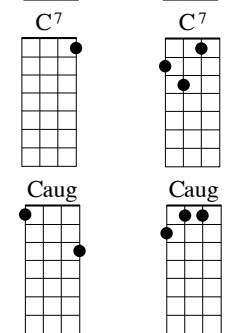

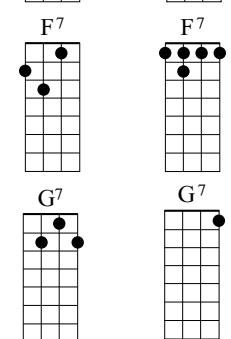
F B^b
